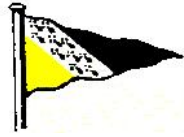

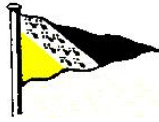

- Note 2: Members bringing additional boats for use during Wroxham Week must notify the Manager for allocation of buoys and moorings. Additional fees are payable.
- Note 3: All boats remaining on Club premises after 1st December 2016 will be charged pro rata at the appropriate fees until removed, unless winter storage has been applied for.
- Note 4: Members requiring winter storage must complete a separate application and send to the Manager with the appropriate fees.
- Note 5: All craft kept at the Club (including all launching trolleys and road trailers) MUST be marked with the owners name for identification purposes.
- Note 6: It is the owner's responsibility to inform the office of meter readings at the point of mooring up and departing your pen.
